Managing retired titles and videos in the Digital Library

How it works

Certain titles or videos may be removed from the Digital Library or retired when the edition is too old or when a new edition is available.

Access to retired titles depends on when your institution's subscription to Editions ENI began:

- If your subscription started before a title was retired, you retain access to that title and the content remains visible with the label **'Previous edition'**.
 - If your subscription started after the title was retired, it is not included in your access and the deep link to this content will not work.
- 🕒 **Reminder:** A deep link to a book or video takes the user directly to that specific content within the library. If the user is not logged into the library when they click the link, they will be directed to the service's login page, and then to the content.



How to identify retired content

To identify retired titles and videos, use the **'Titres et vidéos retirées'*** file provided alongside the MARC21 files.

This file contains:

- a list of retired content
- the 'retirement date'
 - 'date de depreciation' – for the French file
 - 'Fecha de retirada' – for the Spanish file
- the 'new reference' for the replacement edition (if available)
 - 'Nouvelle reference' – for the French file
 - 'Nueva Referencia' – for the Spanish file

*This file is currently only available in French and Spanish since our library isn't fully available in English yet.

How to check a deep link

To check if a deep link is valid:

- 1 - Search for the title or video in the list of retired content
- 2 - Identify the **retirement date**
- 3 - Compare with the **library's upload date**

Result:

- If the removal date is **later** than the upload date → **the link is valid**
- If the removal date is **earlier** than the upload date → **the link is not valid**

- 🕒 **Reminder:** the date your Library went live is shown in your Administrator Guide, which was sent to you when you took out your subscription.
It can also be viewed in the administration console by clicking on the group containing your Library.
